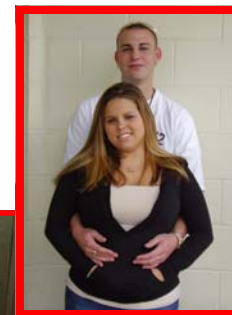

Project PHOENIX offers counseling and support services for youth and families in a contemporary extreme sports atmosphere designed to appeal to young people. Counseling services are free and are designed to meet the needs of both youth and families in the Polk, Highlands, and Hardee counties.

Project PHOENIX also offers **BOUNCE**, a weekly faith-based support/recovery group for youth, and **HEADS UP**, a monthly support group for parents. Topics addressed include, but are not limited to: *anger management, parenting skills, HIV/AIDS, substance abuse prevention and relapse prevention, domestic violence, loss and grief, gang awareness, internet safety, and many more relevant teen issues.*



GET INVOLVED!

The Phoenix HOPE House is an alternative, faith-based, family-modeled living environment for youth who request transitional assistance and/or who are unable to return to their homes of origin. Phoenix HOPE House will provide youth who complete the Polk County S.T.A.R. Program the opportunity to attend school, continue participation in mental health and/or substance abuse support groups and counseling, engage in positive community activities, learn and develop independent living and pro-social skills while residing in a faith-based home environment.
